### **Emmetsburg Public Library Board of Trustees Regular Monthly Meeting**

Conference Room 14; Social Distancing Guidelines Observed

<u>Call to Order:</u> The Emmetsburg Public Library Board of Trustees monthly meeting was called to order by President Dave Carpenter at 5:11 p.m. on Tuesday, November 16, 2021, in the Conference Room 14 of the Emmetsburg Public Library with seat spacing appropriate to social distancing requirement. Trustees present were Carpenter, Sue Brown, Kathy Merrill, Joe Schany, JaDee Gloede, and Joe Veltri. Trustee Jan Stillman joined by telephone. Trustee Marilyn Carlstrom was absent. Library Director Nathan Clark was also present.

<u>Agenda Approval:</u> The agenda prepared by Library Director Clark was posted and distributed in advance of the meeting. Trustee Merrill moved to approve the agenda, which was seconded by Trustee Brown. The motion carried, 8-0.

<u>Minutes Approval:</u> The minutes of the October meeting were prepared by Library Director Clark in advance of the meeting. Trustee Schany made a motion to approve the minutes of the October 2021 meeting. The motion was seconded by Trustee Gloede and carried, 8-0.

<u>Bill Approval</u>: The expenses for the month of October 2021 were read by Library Director Clark. Trustee Merrill moved to approve the expenses of October 2021, which was seconded by Trustee Neff and carried, 8-0.

<u>Public Comment:</u> No members of the public were on hand for the public forum.

**Correspondence:** No correspondence was discussed at the meeting.

**Board Committees:** Finance & Budget Committee: The committee did not meet since the last Board meeting and has no report.

Recruitment & Orientation: The committee did not meet since the last Board meeting and has no report.

Standards & Accreditation: The committee did not meet since the last Board meeting and has no report.

<u>Library Director's Report:</u> Library Director Clark said that there had been several successful programs over the past month. He said that the Edgar Allan Poe program was well attended at 40 attendees and that he received many positive comments about the program. He said that in addition to the usual gaming programs, another Pokémon program was held, which was both full and successful.

Clark said that some other programs struggled to find their audiences and did not have as high of attendance.

Clark shared with the board planned upcoming programs to look for before the next board meeting. He said that tomorrow was a two-hour early out day for the local schools, and the library will be holding both a program for Kindergartners though fourth graders and sugar cookie decorating program aimed at

older children. The following week, programs are scheduled for each day the children are out early or out of school, altogether. These include a retro video game program, a scavenger hunt with prizes and a movie for tweens. A trivia program for tweens is planned for the next week's early out day.

Lastly, Clark shared that he would be the presenter for the program in December on Tuesday, December 14<sup>th</sup> following the book club's discussion of *For All the Tea in China*, where he would give a program about tea. He said that he would also have plenty of teas to taste along with treats. He said there would also be another Pokémon program the next day.

#### **Unfinished Business:**

The policy up for review, the Loan of Equipment-LCD Projector & Portable PA System Policy, was given its second reading. No changes were made at the last meeting and no changes were suggested. Trustee Veltri made a motion to accept the second reading of the Loan of Equipment-LCD Projector & Portable PA System Policy The motion was seconded by Trustee Schany and carried, 8-0.

The policy up for review, the ILCC Library Computer and Acceptable Use Policy, was given its second reading. It is the set of rules governing the public's use of the college computer lab, and the library adopts it for its required computer use policy. Trustee Brown moved to approve the second reading of the ILCC Library Computer and Acceptable Use Policy, and Trustee Gloede seconded the motion. The motion carried, 8-0

Library Director Clark presented a grant proposal to submit to the city for approval for a ceiling mounted digital projector and motorized projector screen with installation, cabling, and mounting hardware. The project totaled \$4,650.00. Kathy Merrill made a motion to apply for a Mini-Grant from PACGDC for "Ceiling-Mounted Projector, Screen & Wiring" in the amount of \$4,650.00. Jan Stillman seconded Motion carried, 8-0.

### **New Business:.**

Library Director Clark reminded the trustees that there had been an initiative to bring more speakers and programs to the library that was begun months before COVID-19 hit. Now, with most restrictions some months distant, the library has resumed the emphasis on in-person programming. Clark spoke of the success of the last two paid speakers and sought approval for continuing to book speakers or performers on a regular basis within the confines of budgetary resources.

Clark provided a sheet promoting an Abraham Lincoln impersonator who he met and whose performance he saw at a recent "Performer's Showcase" that was hosted in Emmetsburg. He said that he would be interested in booking him for February to go along with the Lincoln's Birthday and President's Day holidays. Trustee Gloede stated that she would be interested in hosting the speaker at the school, as well. Trustee Merrill made a motion to explore booking the Lincoln impersonator for a dual engagement at the school and public library. The motion was seconded by Trustee Gloede and carried, 8-0.

<u>Agenda Items for Next Meeting:</u> Trustee Stillman plans to join the meeting by Zoom again in December.

<u>Adjourn:</u> President Carpenter adjourned the meeting at 5:45 p.m. The next meeting of the Board of Trustees is scheduled for Tuesday, December 21, 2021 at the Emmetsburg Public Library.
